Politics

Country, Cantons, Communities Political system and direct democracy Permits and participation rights



Switzerland: 9.034 million inhabitants
Foreigners thereof: 2.4 million

1291: «Rütli Schwur», founding legend of the Old Swiss Confederacy
1848: Foundation of the Swiss Federation
1st of August: National Independence Day



Division of powers:

Legislature (Nationalrat, Ständerat)
Executive (e.g. police)
Judiciary (courts)



26 **Cantons** constitute the Swiss Federation

Canton of Zurich: 1.62 million inhabitants,
17.9% of all inhabitants in Switzerland



Democratic system:

National, cantonal and municipal elections, one vote per Swiss citizen
women's suffrage since 1971

Elections, petitions, referendum;
active and passive voting rights



Bezirk Horgen (regional political district)

Gemeinden Richterswil and Samstagern
(municipalities):
Both combined 14'000 inhabitants



Different permits:

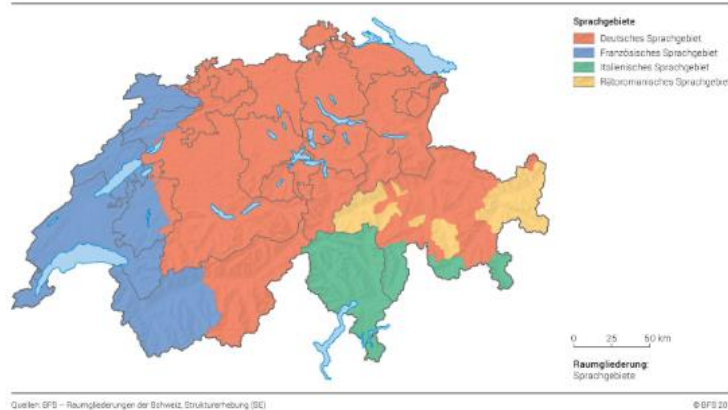
No active or passive voting right on national or cantonal level, but in certain municipalities (not Richterswil/Samstagern though)

Die 4 Sprachgebiete der Schweiz, 2016

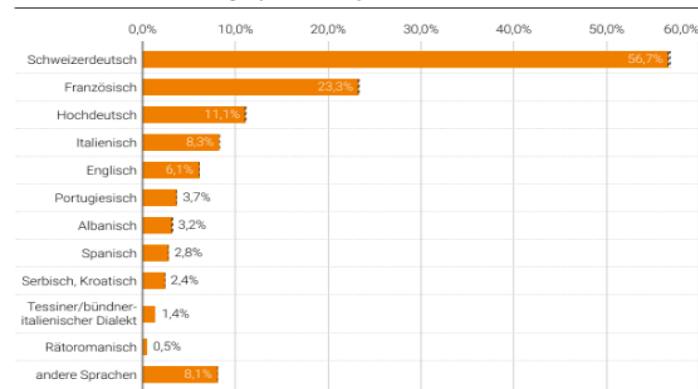


The four national languages of Switzerland are German (orange), French (blue), Italian (green) and Romansh (yellow).

German, or high German is taught in schools in the Canton of Zurich and is the fastest and most promising way to get in touch with people. The colloquial language is Swiss German.

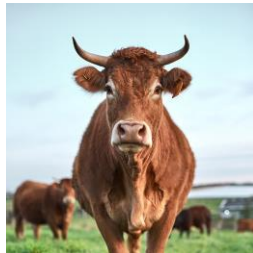
In Switzerland, great importance is placed on order, punctuality, and respect for rules.

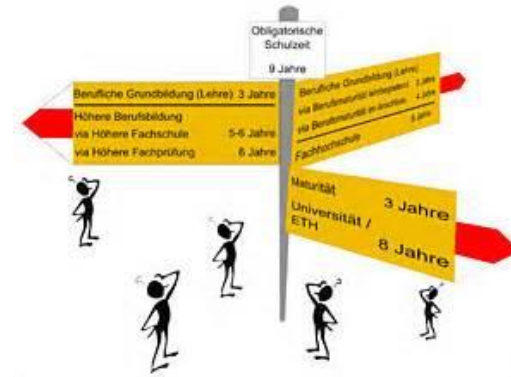
Tax with B and L permit:

- Source tax (Quellensteuer): Tax directly deducted from wages up to CHF 120'000.00 gross

Primary level (Kindergarten and Primarschule)	<u>Compulsory education</u>	4-11
Lower-secondary level (Sekundarschule)	<u>Compulsory education</u>	12-15
Upper-secondary level (Ausbildung / Berufslehre or Gymnasium)	<u>Basic vocational education and training</u> or <u>Secondary schooling</u>	15-19 (also adult education)
Tertiary level (Fachhochschule, Universität)	<u>Professional education institutions</u> or <u>Universities and higher education institutions</u>	19-24 (also adult education)

Social security

➤ Important social insurances:

Old-age and survivors' insurance (AHV)

Disability insurance (IV)

Supplementary benefits (EL)

Income compensation allowance in the event of service, maternity, other parent, caring for a sick child and adoption

Family allowance (FZ)

➤ Other important insurances:

Health insurance (KV) -> mandatory (see next slide)

Accident insurance (UV) -> mandatory (see next slide)

Unemployment insurance (ALV)

Personal liability and household insurance (Haftpflichtversicherung)

Health

Some excerpts from the Health guide to Switzerland:

Health insurance is compulsory
(basic health and accident insurance)

- > Take out health insurance within the first 3 months of your stay
 - > You choose your health insurance company (Compare prices)
 - > Dental and more specialized treatments are not covered by basic health insurance. You are free to take out supplementary insurance
 - > If you work at least 8 hours per week, accident insurance is provided by your employer
- Support with paying basic health insurance for low-income earners

A family doctor (Hausarzt) is the first point of contact for basic medical problems

Pharmacies (Apotheke) can also offer advice

Emergencies: Seespital Horgen (Hospital in Horgen)

Ambulance: 144; Fire brigade: 118; Police: 117

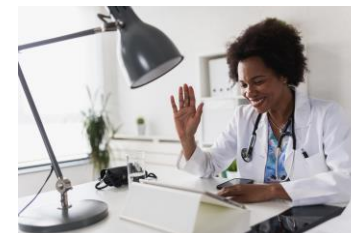

Daily routine in Richterswil

Home life

Waste management: Waste must be separated for recycling

➤ Paper and cardboard must be bundled and will be collected on specific dates in front of your house. Go to calendar and sign up for notifications

Batteries and plastic are returned to stores

➤ Glass bottles and aluminum cans are taken to recycling centers

Organic waste is disposed of in a green container in front of your house (without bag)

Everything else goes in paid garbage bags, which you can get at the supermarket or post office -> dispose of these in the big container in front of your house

Ruhezeiten: Avoid loud noises between 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. and 12 p.m. and 1 p.m.

Dog tax: Register your dog within 10 days

Parking:



Blue zone: Use parking disc, max. 1 hour during day (8 a.m – 7 p.m.). Sat after 6 p.m., Sun and nights for free

White zone: Subject to a fee or free of charge with time restrictions. Check signs and payment machines

Yellow zone: Reserved for private or company use

Transport



Public Transportation:

Purchase train tickets at machine, SBB app, counter

- Different Travelcards
(Half fare, annual GA, GA night, point-to-point card)
- Zone plan Canton Zurich
(Zurich 110 and Winterthur 120 count as two zones)

Children until 6 Years: free

Children 6 to 16 Years: half price, junior travelcard

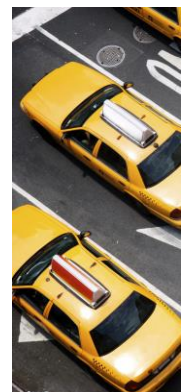
- Spartageskarte Gemeinde
(cheaper day ticket at the residents' registration office Richterswil)

Private Transportation:

Driving license: convert license into a Swiss driving license within a year
(no driving tests for EU citizens)

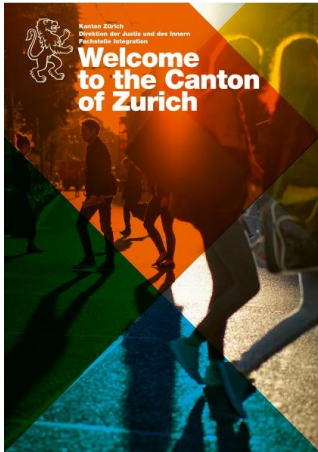
Car: change license plates within one year.
Custom clearance for cars -> insurance mandatory

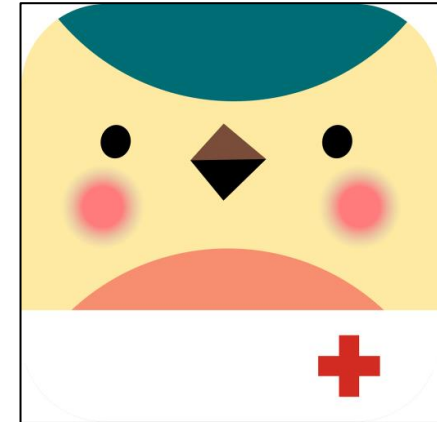
